Trade cards, watch episodes, play Pokémon GO, and join in other activities each month.

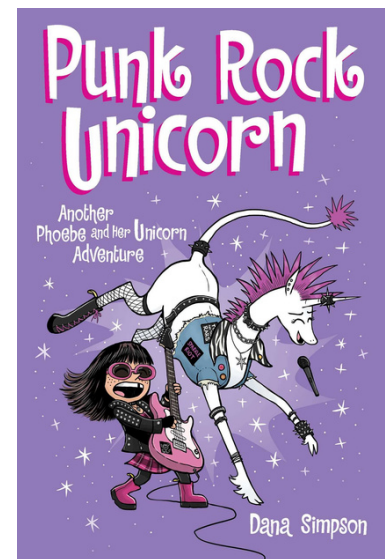
MR. STEVE SUGGESTS:
